You Have the Right to Practice the Cultural and Religious Beliefs of Your Choice!

The right for people with disabilities to practice the religion of their choice is important for several reasons:

- 1. Dignity and Equality: It affirms the inherent dignity of individuals with disabilities and recognizes them as equal members of society with the same rights as others. People with Disabilities deserve the same dignity and equality in all aspects of life including religious practices.
- 2. Social Inclusion and Connections: Ensuring the freedom to practice cultural and religious beliefs fosters diversity and helps to combat social exclusion and discrimination. Many cultural groups and religious communities can provide valuable social connections and a sense of belonging. This is especially important to people with disabilitites since they may face a higher risk for isolation.
- 3. Legal Rights: The right to freedom of religion is protected by laws like the Americans with Disabilitites Act (ADA) and the UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disbailitites
